

Documents You Need for an Uncontested Divorce in New Hampshire

Filing - To file for divorce, you need at least 2 documents, plus the filing fee (\$252 if minor children and \$250 if none):

1. Joint Petition or Individual Petition (notarized)
2. Personal Data Sheet (signed)

Divorce - To get an uncontested divorce, you need these additional documents:

3. Vital Statistics form http://www.courts.state.nh.us/forms/vsform_divorc_cu.pdf
4. Financial Affidavit from wife (notarized)

5. Financial Affidavit from husband (notarized)

Note: Financial Affidavits must be “current,” that is, signed within 30 days prior to filing.

6. Divorce Agreement (Final Decree) (signed and witnessed by an unrelated adult)

Children - If you have one or more minor children, you will also need:

7. Parenting Plan (signed and witnessed by an unrelated adult)
8. Uniform Support Order and Standing Order (signed)
9. Child Support Worksheet
10. Child Impact Seminar certificate for mother (from seminar presenters)
11. Child Impact Seminar certificate for father (from seminar presenters)

The required documents may be filed all at once, or first file numbers 1 and 2, and once you have worked out all issues, file numbers 3-11. If no minor children, there are a minimum of 6 required documents. If you have one or more minor children, the minimum is 11.
